I hereby submit the report of one day Educational Tour (Study Visit) conducted by Department of English on 28/02/2020 to Zilha Parishad, Osmanabad, Lamture Museum, Ancient Temple of Saint Goroba Kaka, Ter and Hatlai Temple, Dist. Osmanabad.

Apart from bookish knowledge, an educational trip is organized on behalf of the Department of English, so that the students can acquire knowledge beyond the four walls. With the intention of student should know the functioning of Government bodies like Zilla Parishad, Panchyat Samiti, etc. we visited Zilla Parishad office at Osmanabad. We got information about how it works during discussion with The President of Honorable Sou. Kambale Madam.

Students read and observe the historical premises and places. The syllabus contains information about historical places, buildings, temples, caves, sculptures, inscriptions and it is also taught to the students in the classroom. But by visiting such places, the knowledge of the students is enhanced. It helps them to get in-depth information and it remains in their memory forever. The second Place of visit was Lamture Museum, Ter, which is of historical significance. Ter, the capital of the Rashtrakutas, has an important place in history. We saw there the antiquities and got information about the old historical places, buildings, temples, caves, sculptures and inscriptions.

Another Place of visit was the Temple of Saint Goroba kaka. Saint Gorob was born in Ter (Dhoki) in the year 1267. Hence the village is popular and known as Goroba Ter. Sant Gora Kumbhar (also known as Goroba) was a Hindu sant associated with the Bhakti movement and the Varkari sect of Maharashtra. He was a potter by trade and devotee of Vithal. The temple of Saint Goroba also attracts tourists and pilgrims to Osmanabad district. The temple was built in the 14th century after the death of Saint Goroba in 1317. This square temple is constructed fully with stone and is one of the best models in architecture. They have also constructed one Sabha Mandap to perform religious and cultural activities. Mostly the pilgrimage those are from rural area and are often visiting to Pandharpur and Tulajapur visit here on their return journey.

We also visited the Hatlai temple which is a scenic place. The students were shocked to see the natural beauty of Hatalai Devi's Temple and Mountain area. Dr. Subhash Rathod, Dr. Laxmi Manshetti Madam, Mr. T. L. Dabde, Dr. Santosh Pawar, Dr. Nilesh Shere, Dr. Laxman Thitte and twenty (20) students were participated in this educational Tour organized by Department of English.
