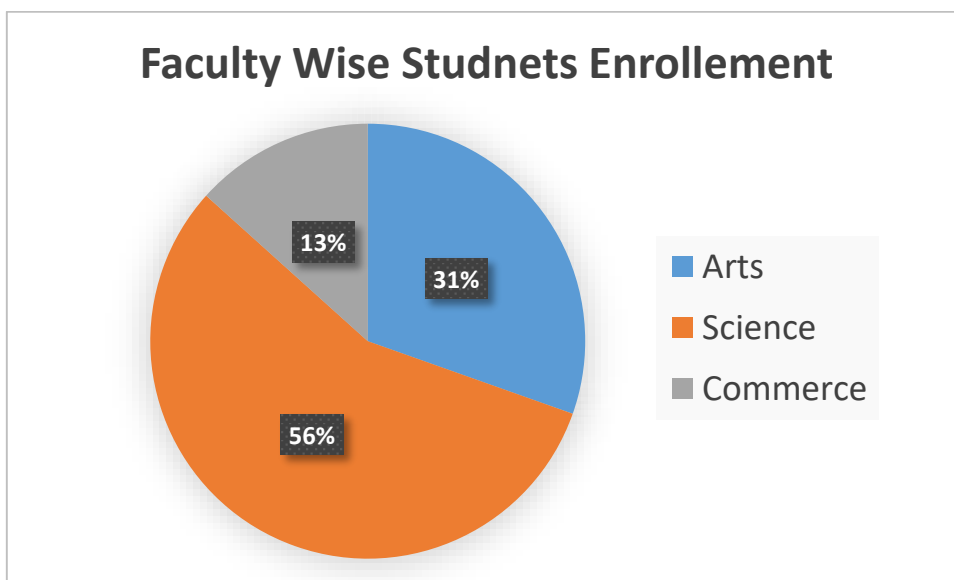

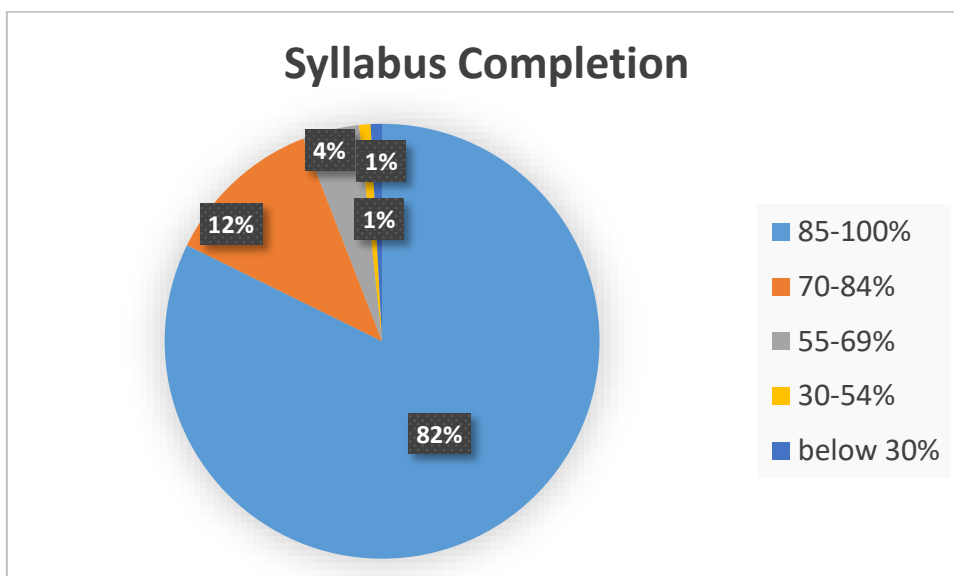

The result of the students satisfaction survey is graphically represented in this report.

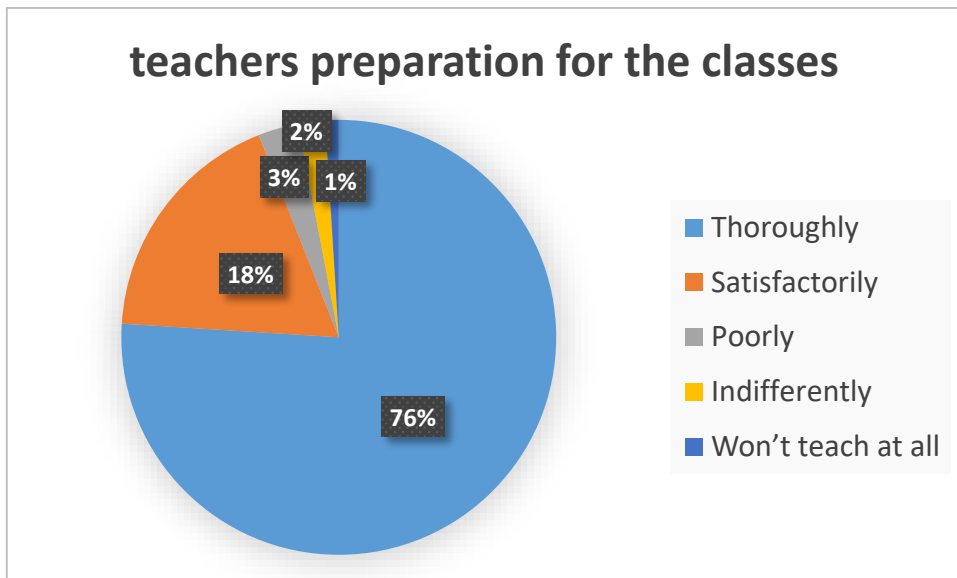
1. Mention the last year of your bachelor degree education: Included 100% last year degree students.

3. What subjects area are you currently pursuing ?



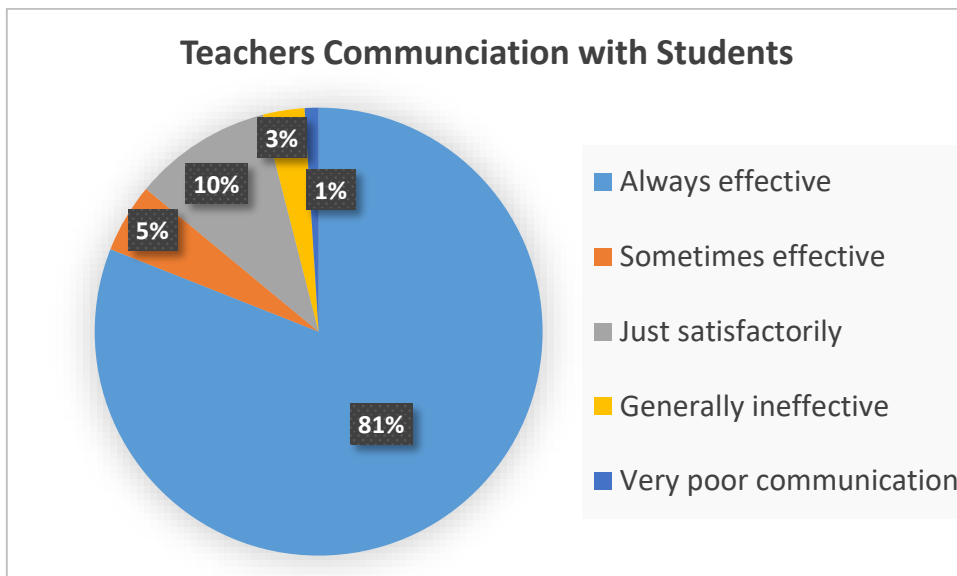

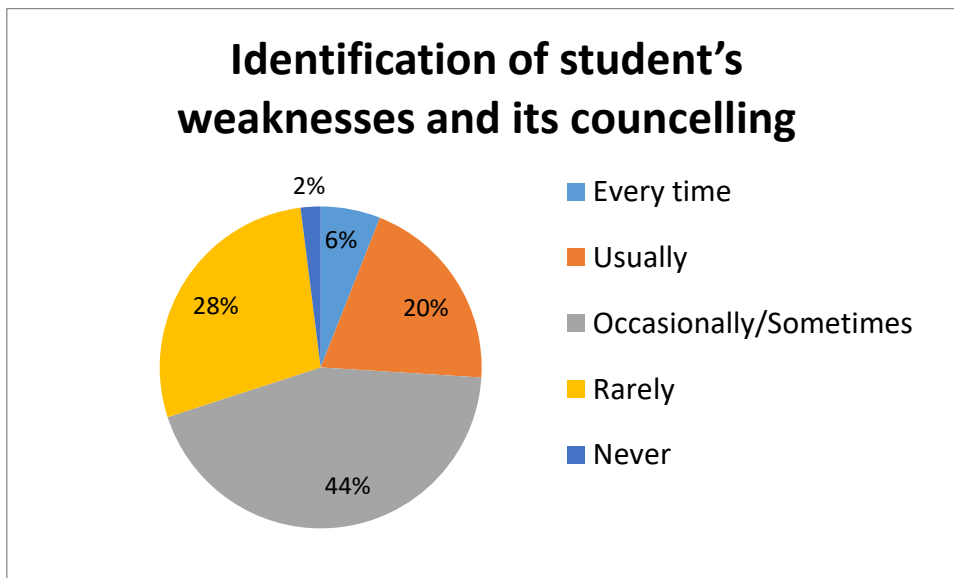

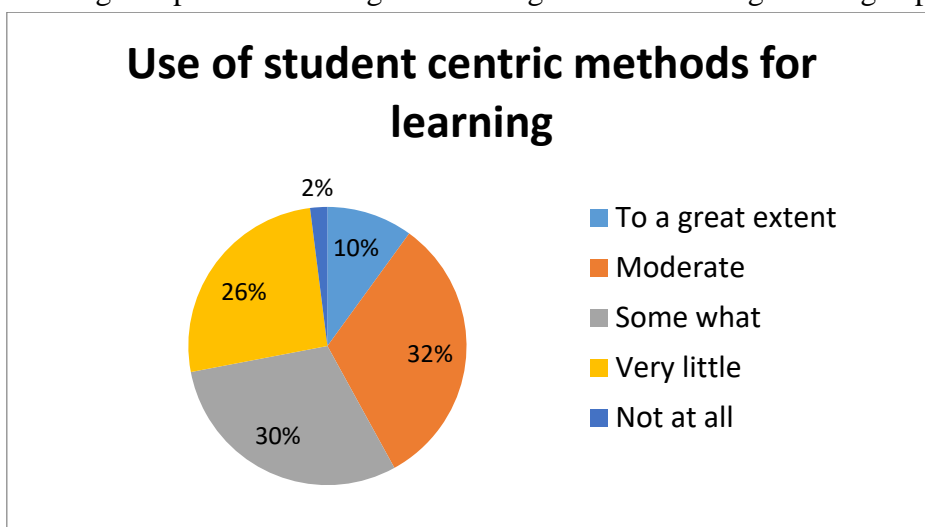

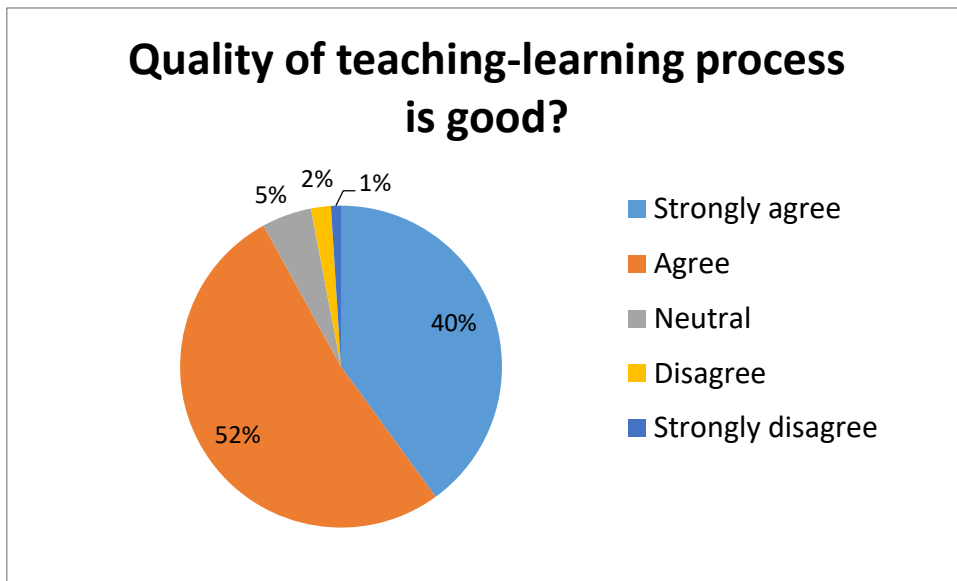
